4) A letter of recommendation from a faculty member and/or professional composer or arranger who is familiar with your work.

Entries will be judged by a 5 member ASMAC panel, and announced in February 2020.

\$1,000 Scholarship *Plus \$500 (2nd place) and \$250 (3rd place)* Deadline for submission - January 15, 2020
